
Starting on June 1st you will now be able to access your SciFinder account via SSO Federated connection:

Let's confirm your identity.


Your institution provided us with some of your information. We need to verify that information to help you access CAS products going forward.

Here is the Account we matched you to.


We were able to match an existing CAS Account with your information. We will now link your Institutional information with your CAS Account.

What is SSO Federated Access?

 It is a secure login method that removes the need to remember and enter usernames and passwords, but still identifies individual users so that you can use features such as alerts and saved searches.

Do I use the same URL as before to access SciFinderⁿ?

Can I still use the previous URL (https://scifinder-n.cas.org/)?

 After we "go live" any users that go to the previous URL will be presented with the 'Access through...' screen after entering their Username or email (instead of being prompted for the CAS password) where they will click to access through TU Clausthal.
